AEST is one of the bible schools we have in western Kenya. It started in 1994 with Pastor Kennedy Okun and later Reverend George opiyo Pile took over. Right now, there are 19 students while 9 other graduated last year with two of them being the one doing phenomenal work of Sunday school teaching and church planting. That is Iyan Anyango and Peter Ochieng' respectively. Most of the graduates of AEST are all in the ministry doing pastoral in market places, some are chaplains in high school and others evangelizing and planting churches.



AEST ADMINISTRATION

AEST have improved a lot in terms of their school fees payment. Last year, a total of 1.1 million was collected in fee revenues as each student paid 40,000 ksh per year and that was a very good record since the school started. Though, this has not been enough and that's why we thank God for Partners in Evangelism international for the support we get from them. We keep on praying for you. God bless you.
