Family Update

Dinah & Jacque – Jacque has completed his surgical residency program with PAACS. In November, they will return to the DRC to do medical work there. They now have 2 boys, Samuel & Jean-Luc.

Anisungu has graduated from the Christian Bilingual University of Congo (UCBC) and is back in Dungu where she is an accountant & teacher at the Congo New School.

Nathan has also graduated from UCBC & is living in Dungu where he is the Head Master at the Congo New School! He is preparing to be married in the near future.

Amini has completed an internship in Kisangani, DRC, and is back with his parents in Beni to finish up his studies there. He then plans to return to Dungu. He has also announced his engagement to be married!

The following are some of the many ministries they have begun & continue to oversee:

- Mboligihe is the director for the RTK Radio ministry in Dungu. This involves producing programming, overseeing & training staff, and acting as liaison with the area & national governing bodies, Invisible Children, and other national & local private radio stations. The radio reaches the community with the Gospel message and with health & safety education. At least one new radio station is planned in 2015.
- ❖ He oversees the Congo New Primary School in Dungu. The school is called the "Complexe Scolaire Pépinière De Dieu" (CSPD), translated "Complex Nursery School Of God". It consists of a primary, secondary and trade school. He organized a parent team to build 4 new classrooms to accommodate the growing student population. His son, Nathan, & daughter, Anisungu, are now also working at the school. Through a scholarship program, the Mboligihe's have made it possible for several men and

women to get an education and return to Dungu as teachers at the school. The school has grown to over 500 students in only its third year!

- ❖ Mboligihe is the deputy pastor of the Dungu Section General Assembly which includes preaching at many area churches, mediating church conflicts & reconciliations, baptizing new believers, encouraging the local pastors, participating in the ordination & sending out of new pastors, teaching at Youth Conferences, attending the executive church council meetings, providing marriage counseling, etc.
- ❖ He conducts trauma counseling training workshops at area churches, and does many one-on-one counseling sessions with individuals needing spiritual & emotional care, including area pastors seeking counsel & advice.
- ❖ Mboligihe is on the Managing Committee for the Dungu-May Health Center which he helped build. Plans are being made to bring in trainers in general dentistry and dental hygiene in 2015.
- ❖ Yoana recently finished her secondary education studies, passed the government exams, & graduated with highest honors. She will act as Matron to the girls at the new school. Now that she has completed her studies, she will have more time to devote to LIBAMA Women's Ministries, a ministry that she initiated and oversees. Through LIBAMA, women are taught how to sew, garden, raise farm animals, make soap, etc. for sale in the marketplace. The women meet regularly for Bible study as well.
- ❖ Praise God for the **funds we were able to raise** at a fundraising dinner held in April 2014. These funds are being used towards educational scholarships, repair of their old truck, a Women's Ministries office, construction of a guest house, etc. Further funds are needed for a new truck, an RTK radio transmitter, & a multi-purpose school facility.
