### **1. Evangelism:**

-We organized a massive Evangelical event in Noua-Sulita for 6000 people. 17 youths received Christ, one of which has since been baptized.

-We also had a full week of evangelism with all of the churches, and 5 people received Christ, bless the Lord!

-Once a week the youths from the churches did evangelism in the central area of Noua-Sulita.

Each listener received a New Testament. These individuals were all invited to visit our churches.

### **2. Camp:**

-We organized summer camp in August for 150 teens, and 50 of them accepted Christ as their Savior.

-Every church held VBS, and each one hosted at least 50 children.

### 3. Orphanages:

-We had a special camp for orphans in which we gave each child food and gifts. There were 185 orphan children at this camp.

-We helped 200 orphans from Sadagura (in Chernovtsy) get school supplies.

-We went to 2 orphanages in Hotin and saw 350 children. Each one received a nice gift, 2 apples, fresh food, and clothing.

-At the beginning of 2016 we organized an event for families who have taken in orphans. At the meeting we preached the Gospel, and each child received a gift and 2 meals.



### 4. Work with the Refugees:

-We helped a family of refugees who lost their home in the war zone to raise funds and buy a house in Sherbinta, where this family now Evangelizes and helps the church there, Praise the Lord!



-Pavel Petihachny visited the war zone where I used funds raised by you to preach the Gospel of Peace there.

-Brother Kioresko also helped in the war zone.

### 5. Theological Institute:

-Brothers Petihachny and Postusak teach at the Theological Institute to prepare new missionaries for the work of the Lord.



## 6. Women's Ministry:

-Sister Larisa regularly organizes the women of the churches to gather in Chernovtsy to pray and help the poor and sick. These sisters raise funds to help pay for the medical needs of people who can't afford it.



## 7. Baptisms:

-Every PIEI-Ukraine Missionary held baptisms this year, and a total of 31 people were baptized, Praise the Lord!
